ACTION STEPS

- Provide access to adequate and affordable housing
- Provide transportation access to work, behavioral, and medical appointments
- Develop volunteer transportation network
- Promote physical health and well-being
- Provide access to addiction recovery resources
- Ensure everyone has access to a medical home and medical insurance
- Develop emotional health, resilience, hope, and freedom from past pain in order to function in society and meet the demands of everyday life
- Develop interpersonal skills necessary to thrive in workplace and social settings
- Develop the language of negotiation
- Create a network of healthy social capital
- Provide connections to local churches and spiritual resources to provide hope, healing, and a healthy social capital (mentors and advocates)
- Provide GED classes
- Provide avenues for continuing education
- Provide job readiness skills necessary to secure and keep employment
- Advocate with employers to provide living wages
- Provide financial workshops and resources
- Help bridge gap as individuals get off welfare benefits
